

# What We're Building:

## The Purpose Behind the Election Prayers Program



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As a nation stands on the edge of decision, we stand in the gap.

The *Election Prayers Program* is more than a devotional or a countdown to the polls - it's a strategic call to align hearts with Heaven, to quiet the chaos of political noise, and to invite a deeper, collective dependence on God. Over four weeks, through daily prayers rooted in Scripture, we're not just preparing for an election - we're cultivating a posture of prayer, humility, and trust in the One who reigns above it all.

### A Four-Week Build-Up of Spiritual Momentum

The four weeks are thematically woven to guide hearts toward both intimacy and action. We don't start with public policy or bold declarations. We begin where transformation always begins: the heart.

#### Week 1: Drawing Near

This is the foundation. Before we pray for our country, we return to personal closeness with God. We quiet distractions, confess apathy and rekindle hunger for His presence. We emphasize that revival doesn't start in the streets - it starts in surrendered hearts.

#### Week 2: Truth and Discernment

In a world of spin, we ask for clarity. These days focus on renewing our minds, discerning God's will, and embracing a truth that cuts through deception. We pray for eyes to see, ears to hear, and courage to stand for what is right - without becoming hardened or angry.

#### Week 3: Unity and Purpose

This is about the Church rising - not as a voting bloc, but as a body united in love, purpose, and mission. We pray against division, cynicism, and fear. We ask that God would raise up leaders of integrity and that His people would be salt and light in tangible, local ways.

#### Week 4: Hope and Boldness

As the election draws near, we lift our eyes. We pray with expectancy, not dread. These final days are marked by declarations of hope, courage to act, and faith that God is not done with our nation. We lean in with boldness - asking for more than a good result. We ask for a spiritual awakening.

## The Big Picture

*“For where two or three gather in my name, there am I with them.”*

**Matthew 18:20 (NIV)**

We're after hearts turned toward God.

This isn't about headlines or hashtags. It's not about choosing sides or raising voices louder than the rest. What we're after is far quieter, and far more powerful.

The *Election Prayer Program* isn't a political campaign - it's a spiritual call. We're inviting people, not to react, but to return. Not to posture, but to pray. Because we believe something happens when God's people gather - not in crowds, but in unity.

That's where it begins. Around kitchen tables. In the early morning silence. On walks, in cars, in whispered prayers during busy days. Revival doesn't need a stage. It just needs surrendered hearts.

We're calling a remnant to rise - not with clenched fists, but with open hands. Not with partisan slogans, but with kingdom clarity. Not stirred by fear, but anchored in truth. We are asking God to awaken Canada - not just to political awareness, but to spiritual hunger.

This isn't about promoting a candidate, party, or policy. It's about preparing hearts to vote with wisdom, speak with grace, and live with conviction. It's about homes becoming havens of prayer, and churches becoming launchpads for justice and mercy. It's about conversations - at dinner tables and in break rooms - being laced with faith, not fear.

May it serve as both an anchor and invitation - for every believer, every pastor, and every household that dares to believe that prayer still shifts atmospheres, still shapes nations, and still moves the heart of God.

## Election Lead-Up Prayer - Day 1, April 1, 2025

**Theme:** Return & Rebuild

**Scripture:** 2 Chronicles 7:14 (NIV)

“If my people, who are called by my name, will humble themselves and pray and seek my face and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven, and I will forgive their sin and will heal their land.”

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### Prayer:

Lord,

Before we speak to a nation, we must kneel before **You**. Before we ask for awakening, we must first repent for drifting. **You** are not waiting for a crowd - **You** are waiting for **Your people**. And we are here.

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### Prayer:

## Election Lead-Up Prayer - Day 13, April 13, 2025

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### Prayer:

Father,

**You** have not made **Your** will a mystery. **You** have shown us clearly what **You** desire - justice, mercy, and humility. **Yet** in a world addicted to outrage and self-promotion, these virtues often feel upside down.
